



## Build your own Dartball Dartboard!

Dartball Dartboard can vary so this board is based on the Wisconsin Dartball Dartboard

You will require a 48" (4' square) ½" thick PLYWOOD board to construct the dartboard

Divide the target area into sections illustrated in the Dats501 Dartball Dartboard Diagram

### Official Paint Colours:

|                     |               |              |
|---------------------|---------------|--------------|
| S                   | STRIKE        | Medium Grey  |
| O                   | OUT           | Orange       |
| F                   | FOUL          | Pale Green   |
| B                   | BALL          | Medium Blue  |
| DP                  | DOUBLE PLAY   | Cardinal Red |
| SH                  | SACRIFICE HIT | Cardinal Red |
| NUMBERS / LETTERING |               | Black        |

## Numbers and Lettering

Official Dartball Dartboards have to compile with the following dimensions for the Numbering and Lettering:

### The style for Numbers and Words; Plain Block
